## Facts about the Hotel Fairview and the Fire

- The hotel was built in 1898 and opened on July 1, 1899
- It was a square building 60 feet long and 60 feet wide with a tower on the roof
- The hotel was famous for its good food
- It had a 50 foot long bar with crystal lamps and mirrors behind it
- There were 28 bedrooms
- There was a wide main staircase that went from the ground floor to the third floor, and a back staircase
- Mr. Mathias was the manager, and his wife and child lived in the hotel with him
- 14 people were staying in the hotel the night of the fire
- The fire happened at night during hot dry weather
- Mrs. Mathias and her child jumped from a window and escaped
- Several people were killed, including Mr. Mathias and the schoolteacher Miss Louise Smith.
- Nearby pharmacists helped injured guests by putting medicine on their burns.
